During chemotherapy at Woman's Hospital, Kelli spotted a woman next to her who had lost a good deal of weight and had to pin her oversized skirt. Realizing some women were not as fortunate as her to afford new clothing, she aspired to start a closet where women undergoing treatment could find new, properly fitted clothing for free. Her parents were able to fulfill her wishes in 2014 when they opened Kelli's Kloset and a mobile shop.
